REPORTS

Too many to list recently, several of note however:-

Scheduled:

- 117 <u>Rowe Ditch</u> Part of this has been recently bulldozed away.
- 121 <u>Titley Ring Work</u> Difficult to find now due to repeated ploughing since 1914.
- 143 <u>King Arthur's Cave</u> Direction board disappeared. Fires often lit here, broken bottles, etc., etc.
- 144 <u>Leominster Castle Moat</u> Don't look for it, it has been built over after being excavated and found to be a moated medieval farmhouse.
- 48 <u>Offa's Dyke</u> Track been bulldozed through on the west of Rushock Hill, and on entry to Kennels Wood.

Unscheduled:

- U73 <u>White Stone</u> Apparently this was first a wayside cross and was turned into a milestone in 1700. Now rather worn.
- U77 <u>Lower Lyde Long Barrow?</u> 25ft high and 90ft long with trees on top. Could be a long barrow any comments?
- U29 <u>Wergins Stone</u> Condition deteriorating rapidly. Overgrown by hedge and weeds. Base stone split.
- U77 <u>Garway Hill Earthwork</u> On path from Garway Hill PO to summit of Garway Hill. Rectangular area with rampart and fosse. Traces of 2 entries. Approx 170ft x 190ft.
- U80 <u>Bredwardine Castle No. 2</u> Further downstream to Schedule One. Stone walls, banking for stream to give wet moat.

The above are just a sample of the reports that are coming in. I haven't mentioned all those which say "No change" for condition, although these will be more useful to determine the damage if any occurs.
