

Herefordshire ceramics type fabric series (Romano-British pottery found in Herefordshire)

Central Gaulish glazed ware

Green-glazed on a white or pale brown fabric. Central Gaulish 1st and 2nd centuries AD. Widely distributed but rare, although pot of this type has been found at Ariconium.¹ (Willis, 2008) and Blackwardine² in 1981.
