

Romano-British pottery found in Herefordshire

Oxfordshire white mortaria

2nd to 4th century

Made in the area which is now Oxfordshire from the 2nd century when they mainly circulated in Oxfordshire and the adjacent counties. More widely distributed from the mid 3rd century
A hard fabric with moderate black and red quartz inclusions.
