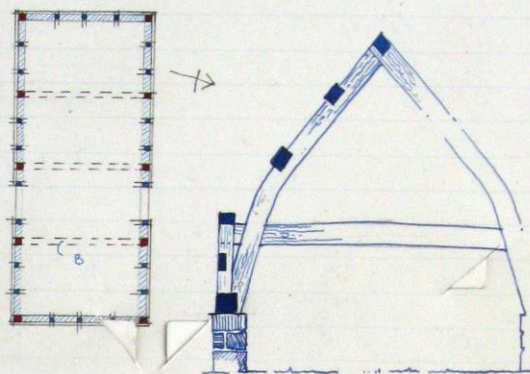

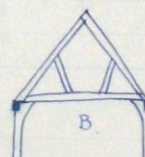

Gabled at E & W. ends. The framing is largely exposed when not hung with large stone slates. These stone slates are apparently a modern addition as there would appear originally to have been some kind of intermediate balusters or small posts, as along underside of plate on both sides of beam the mortises can be seen. The barn consists of 4 bays divided by 3 trusses two of which are crutches while the third, or most Easterly is of open shew in sketch 'B'. Each end wall of barn is framed of a similar crutch to the trusses already mentioned except that they have collar beams as well as tie beams. The second bay from E has on each side of beam a wide double door. At E end the stone plinth has been built up to underside of tie beam.

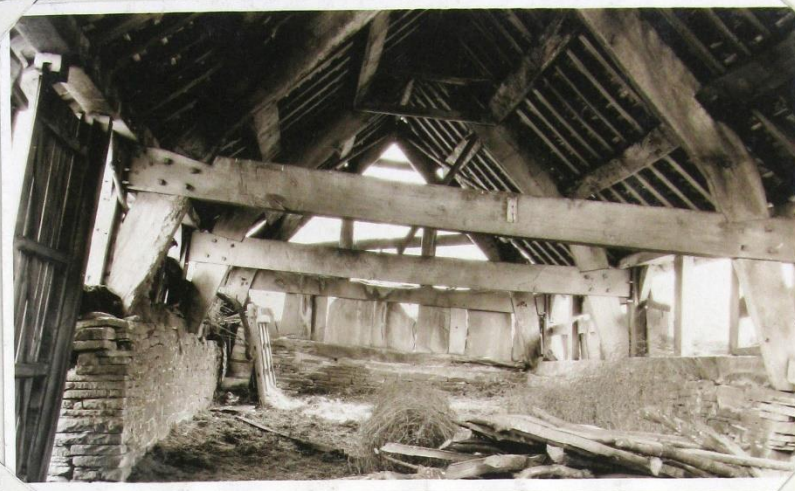
About 40 yds N.W of barn are ruins of farmhouse very little now stands but it would appear to have been a rectangular building. In portion wall left standing are 2 single light stone windows with chamfered heads, joints, sills. What little remains would incline me to estimate the date of this house to probably be much the same as that of the Barn.
